Over the summer the regular team will be taking a well-earned break. A big thank you to all of them for what they have done in the past school year.

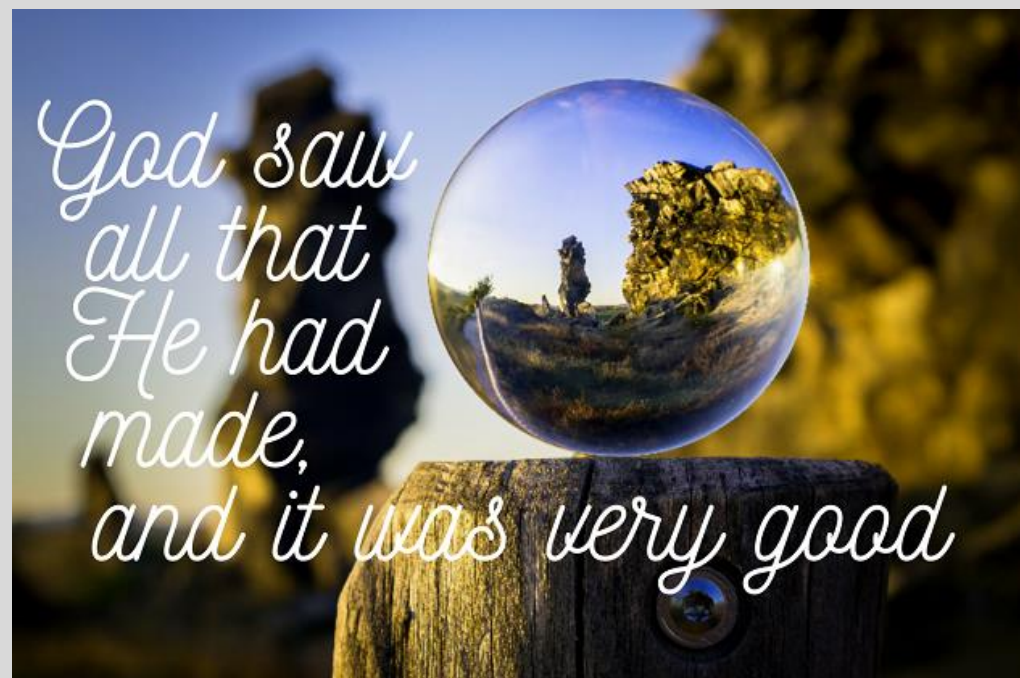
